





#### Public and Private Investment in Infrastructure in LAC 1980-2013

















#### **ELECTRICITY LOSSES**



3x the losses levels of OECD countries





#### **INFRASTRUCTURE PORTFOLIO: 2008 - 2015**


#### APPROVED LOANS BY REGION

(US\$ million)




#### APPROVED LOANS BY SECTOR
